The European Union's Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Directive was implemented in member states during 2006. There are a number of obligations imposed on The Kenton Group as a supplier of electrical and electronic equipment. The Kenton Group's compliance approach for these obligations is provided below.

### WEEE Marking



All products that are subject to the WEEE Directive supplied by The Kenton Group from 13th August 2005 are compliant with the WEEE marking requirements. Such products are marked with the "crossed out wheeled bin" WEEE symbol shown right in accordance with European Standard EN 50419

## ***The Kenton Group Restriction on Hazardous Substances (RoHS) statement***

The Council of The European Union and The European Parliament has issued a directive known as the Restriction on Hazardous Substances (RoHS). This directive (2002/95/EC) restricts the use of certain substances deemed hazardous by the EU and used in electrical and electronic components and products.

The directive requires that, beginning July 1, 2006, new electrical and electronic equipment put on the market does not contain Lead (Pb), Mercury (Hg), Cadmium (Cd), Hexavalent Chromium (Cr6+), Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB), or Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE). The maximum concentration levels, by weight per homogeneous material, have been set by the Technical Adaptation Committee (TAC) at 0.01% for Cadmium and 0.1% for the remaining substances.

The Kenton Group is continually working with our partners and suppliers and is committed to supplying RoHS compliant products to our worldwide customer base .
