The Kenton Group recognises its responsibilities and obligations under all current National and European legislation related to WEEE.

The Group is working closely with our suppliers to ensure our complete compliance with the directives in accordance with the current timetable, (as issued by the UK Department of Trade and Industry).

As information becomes available from the suppliers related to the WEEE regulations and the methods of disposal the Group will provide information on line and via our account managers. The Kenton Group is committed to supporting our customers to ensure that disposal of WEEE products is achieved with minimum effort.

The Kenton Group requires our suppliers to ensure that all products, (that fall within the scope of the Directive), will be labelled with the “Do not Dispose of in Household Waste” label as prescribed in article 10 of the WEEE Directive.

The Kenton Group has contracted with an approved Environment Agency for the disposal of all WEEE related products: under Certificate number WEE/BD0324XQ.
